## **Let's Make a Decorated Box!**

with Pro Marine Supplies & Liquid Resonance

# Materials

1. Wooden Box (Any Size)
2. Pro Marine Supplies Tabletop Epoxy Resin
3. Stirring Stick
4. (4) Utility Measuring Cups (sold at most hardware stores)
5. Paper/Plastic cups.
6. Painters Tape
7. Black Acrylic Paint
8. Crystals/Gems/Glitter (optional)
9. Pigment Powder
10. Hand Torch/Heat Gun
11. Gloves
12. Rubbing Alcohol
13. Microfiber Towel

# Making the Box

## Step-By-Step Instructions

1. Prep and sand the surface. Clean with microfiber cloth.
2. Tape all the edges and the bottom to avoid any resin drips and to get a nice clean edge.
3. Paint the surface black and add a very thin layer of resin as a base.
4. NOTE: When using resin on wood, it is advised to add a thin base layer so that the resin doesn't soak into the wood. We call this a “Seal Coat”
5. Put on your Gloves and mix 8 oz. (4 oz. part A, 4 oz. Part B) of Epoxy-Resin. Follow Pro Marine Supplies Mixing Instructions. This will be your “Seal Coat”.
6. Pour your Seal Coat over the board and spread with a foam brush.
7. Let your seal coat harden (~4-6 hours).
8. Add your pigments into your paper/plastic cups. The colors I used in the main pour are from just4youonlineuk my favorite pigment company 😊❤️ I used black, emerald, titanium white, and bright gold.
9. Put on new Gloves and mix 8 oz. (4 oz. part A, 4 oz. Part B) of Epoxy-Resin. Follow Pro Marine Supplies Mixing Instructions.
10. Pour mixed epoxy into the pigments.
11. Move the heat gun around to blend the colors together and create ‘cells’.
12. Let harden for about 4 to 6 hours, then peel all that tape off to reveal your nice clean edge 😊
13. Let fully cure for ~72 hours & enjoy!

I use Pro Marine Supplies, and even though I am an ambassador, I have been using their products almost exclusively since starting my journey. They are super low cost for the quality you get in a resin, and you get a glass-like finish every time!
