Let's Make a Cutting Board!

with Pro Marine Supplies

Materials

1. Wooden Cutting Board (Any Size)
2. White Acrylic Paint
3. Pro Marine Supplies Tabletop Epoxy Resin
4. Stirring Stick
5. (4) Utility Measuring Cups (sold at most hardware stores)
6. Paper/Plastic cups.
7. Painters Tape
8. Crystals/Gems/Glitter (optional)
9. Pigment Powder
10. Hand Torch
11. Heat Gun
12. Gloves
13. Rubbing Alcohol
14. Paper Towels
15. Foam Brush
16. Dust Mask
17. Safety Glasses
18. Lemon Oil

Making the Cutting Board

Step-By-Step Instructions

1. Clean off the surface of the wood with Alcohol and a Paper Towel.
2. Tape off the areas you don't want the Epoxy mixture to run.
3. Paint the area that you intend to pour the epoxy with white acrylic paint.
4. Using a heat gun, dry the paint.
5. Dump the pigment powder you want to use in the paper/plastic cups.
6. Put on your Gloves and mix 8 oz. (4 oz. part A, 4 oz. Part B) of Epoxy Resin.

7. Distribute the Epoxy into the pigments.
8. Mix the colors into the epoxy.
9. Pour the pigmented epoxy into any pattern you like.
10. Use heat gun to blend the colors (optional)
11. Torch out any air bubbles.
12. Let the epoxy get tacky (~2-4 hours)
13. Place the gems/crystals/glitter on the epoxy.
14. Touch up the sides and bottom of the project.
15. Use heat gun to blend the colors together.
16. Let the Epoxy Resin cure for ~72 hours in a clean, dust free environment at 75-80°F.
17. After your project has cured, sand off any unwanted epoxy.
18. Use your lemon oil on the wooden parts of the board.
19. Voila, complete!
