Let's Make a Keepsake Photo Board!

with Pro Marine Supplies

Materials

1. A square piece of wood
2. Pro Marine Supplies Tabletop Epoxy Resin
3. Photos (4x6 or smaller)
4. Stirring Stick
5. (4) Utility Measuring Cups (sold at most hardware stores)
6. Hand Torch
7. Gloves
8. Mod Podge Acrylic Sealer
9. Rubbing Alcohol
10. Paper Towels
11. Foam Brush
12. Sandpaper
13. Glue

Making the Keepsake Board

Step-By-Step Instructions

1. Clean off the surface of the wood with Alcohol and a Paper Towel.
2. Put on your Gloves and mix 8 oz. (4 oz. part A, 4 oz. Part B) of Epoxy Resin. Follow Pro Marine Supplies Mixing Instructions. This will be your “Seal Coat”.
3. Pour your Seal Coat over the board and spread with a foam brush.
4. Torch out any air bubbles.
5. Pour a second coat.
6. Torch out any air bubbles.
7. Allow Seal Coat to get tacky (~3-6 hours.)
8. Place photos on the sticky surface.
9. Coat with Mod Podge Acrylic Sealer and let dry. (Use a heat gun to help speed up the drying process)
10. Using new containers, mix equal parts Resin and Hardener (Part A and Part B). Follow Pro Marine Supplies Mixing Instructions. This will be your “Flood Coat”.
11. Pour your thoroughly mixed Epoxy-Resin over the surface of the board and spread with foam brush.
12. Remove excess Epoxy Resin.
13. Torch every 3-5 minutes to remove surfaced air bubbles, until bubbles disappear.
14. Let the Epoxy Resin cure for ~72 hours in a clean, dust free environment at 75-80°F.
15. Place anywhere inside your home!
