Making an Epoxy-Resin Lazy Susan

with Pro Marine Supplies

Materials

1. Lazy Susan (any size)
2. Pro Marine Supplies Epoxy Resin
3. 4 oz. Paper/Plastic Cups
4. Alcohol Ink/Pigment Powder (depending upon desired colors & effects)
5. Stirring Stick(s)
6. (2) Utility Measuring Cups (sold at most hardware stores)
7. Heat Gun/Hand Torch
8. Gold/Silver Paint (optional)
9. Gloves
10. Alcohol
11. Tape

Making a Lazy Susan

Step-By-Step Instructions

1. Clean the surface of your Lazy Susan with alcohol and let air dry. Tape off the bottom and edges.
2. Put on your Gloves and mix 16 oz. (8 oz. part A, 8 oz. Part B) of Epoxy-Resin. Follow [Pro Marine Supplies Mixing Instructions](#); pour half a cup's worth of Resin in each 4 oz. cup and mix in alcohol ink/powder.
3. Pour your colored Epoxy Resin on the Lazy Susan in any pattern desired; leveling out the surface layer by spinning the Lazy Susan. (If you have any leftover Epoxy Resin, you can use it in any molds you may have handy.)
4. Remove surface air bubbles (with heat gun/hand torch) every 15 minutes until bubbles disappear and let epoxy resin harden (4-6 hours).
5. After 4-6 hours, remove the tape from the bottom and edges of your project. Be careful not to touch the curing project, you could leave a fingerprint ;)
6. After removing the tape, let cure for another 66-68 hours.
7. Once cured, paint the edges with your Gold/Silver Paint and let dry.
8. When dry, add to any living area for a convenient and decorative centerpiece!
